Sac & Fox Casino Implements an Aggressive Health and Sanitation Program.

Antimicrobial Coating, Non-Touch Infrared Body Thermometers, Physical Distancing and More

The Tribal Council of the Sac and Fox Nation of Missouri in Kansas and Nebraska has announced the reopening of the Sac and Fox Casino set for June 1, 2020. The casino management team has created and implemented an extensive and aggressive health and sanitation program to safeguard guests, team members and the surrounding communities. The new program outlines several new initiatives throughout the property to ensure a safe and healthy environment upon reopening.

“The new health and sanitation program we have developed here at Sac & Fox Casino is designed to follow the reopening guidelines and demonstrates our commitment to protecting the health and safety of our guests, team members and our surrounding communities, said Bruce McClure, General Manager. “We have been preparing for the reopening since we temporarily closed the casino on March 18, 2020. The new health and sanitation program will implement new measures in the areas of departmental cleaning and sanitizing protocols. We want everyone to come to Sac & Fox Casino and feel confident that we are doing all we can to protect and safeguard their health while they play at our casino.”

With the new health and sanitation program, it was important to find additional resources for the prevention and sanitation best practice methods. One of the major initiatives in the new program includes an exciting partnership with San Diego-based Company, TruClean to apply their new revolutionary self-cleaning antimicrobial surface coating throughout the 52,000 square foot casino property. TruClean’s surface-bonding “sword like” coating is registered internationally as a long term disinfectant that destroys bacteria and viruses on contact. Countries including South Korea, Singapore, China, Brazil and South Africa are actively using this surface coating technology and this antimicrobial coating is an EPA registered treated article that inhibits the growth of microorganisms with a single application for up to a year.

TruClean’s invisible, non-toxic coating has been applied throughout the property, including the lodge restaurant, café, casino bar, gaming machines and table games, silver fox showroom and bingo, back of house and team member areas, kitchens, restrooms, floors and carpets, handrails, buttons, chairs,

dining room tables, countertops, ATM/Kiosks, POS systems, flooring, windows, doors and all high-contact touch points.

Additionally, Sac & Fox Casino Security Team at the casino entrances will begin using non-invasive temperature checks utilizing the Non-touch Infrared Body Thermometer. Anyone displaying a temperature of 100.0F will be taken aside for a secondary temporal temperature screening. Guests, team members and vendors confirmed to have a temperature of over 100.0F will not be allowed entry to the casino and will be asked to seek an evaluation from their health provider.

Guests will be strongly encouraged to bring and wear cloth masks (cotton material) at all times on the gaming floor. All guests wishing to visit the casino will be requested to briefly lower their masks for age identification purposes.

Guests will be directed to practice physical distancing with floor decals to display standing at least six feet away from other people they have not traveled with while standing in lines, or moving around the casino floor. Sac & Fox Casino has also installed Plexiglas shields in close contact areas, winner's club, casino cage, security post, restaurants, gift shop and bingo.

Table games will be limited to a max of three players per table, the craps table will be limited to four players, every other slot machine will be turned off for a safer distance between players and all slots and tables will be cleaned frequently. Bingo has been reduced from 240 to 120 seats with four players per table instead of the traditional eight player per table.

Team members will be required and provided with personal protective equipment (PPE) to wear during their shifts and will be trained extensively on the new health and sanitation protocols and proper disposal of gloves and masks.

Team members will be required to wear cloth masks (supplied by Sac & Fox Casino) and disposable rubber gloves as appropriate for winner's club, food & beverage, slot personnel, security, bingo, casino cage, housekeeping and facilities. Table games will be required to only wear masks.

There will be health and hygiene reminders throughout the property and restrooms to remind our guests and team members to wash your hands, we recommend all guests to wear a cloth facial mask and wear gloves during their visit.

Sac & Fox Casino's health and sanitation program has been reviewed and approved by the Sac & Fox Tribal Council and the Sac & Fox Gaming Commission. The plan has been reviewed and incorporated into the pre-opening checklist guidance from the NIGC, EPA, OSHA, the White House gating criteria and related recommendations from CDC, the Kansas Governor's office and State Health guidelines.
